TCOE India: International Collaboration

- ITU-R has accepted TCOE India as one of the <u>12 evaluating groups</u> for the radio interface technology candidate for IMT-A standards (4G technology)
- The two likely candidates are IEEE 802.16m (WiMAX) and LTE-A (3GPP). This opportunity will benefit the TCOEs through:
- Capacity building and contributions to the standardization activities
- Providing TCOE sponsors an opportunity for thorough evaluation of the 4G standards
- Generation of pool of engineers with expertise on 4G standards for the Indian telecom industry, setting the stage for TCOE to generate IPRs
- Formation of working groups for the evaluation is underway and a training
